TRACEABILITY

- EC REG 834/2007 art. 27 par. 13: traceability in line with the art. 18 of the EEC REG 178/2002 in order to guarantee the integrity of the organic products.
- EC REG 834/2007 art. 24: traceability is the main instrument in order to trace and guarantee the origin of the agricultural ingredients for the correct labelling (EU/not EU).
- traceability is basic for to guarantee the organic status of the seeds, seedlings, younger animals and all allowed inputs in the organic process.
- traceability is the main "tool" for to trace back the products lot in case of suspect, irregularities or infractions.



ROLES AND RESPONSABILITIES IN THE CERTIFICATION SYSTEM

IT IS IMPORTANT TO PREVENT THE LACK OF TRACEABILITY

- Distinguish the cases of irreguarities and infractions other than those of frauds.
- The organic sector is not longer suited to other fraud
- But in the organic sector the price can be attractive and we have to be more careful in some step of the chains.
- The traceability is part of the organic method
